

Minutes Westwood Neighborhood Association 9/11/2019

Cindy presented the Treasurers Report, as of 8/13/2019 we had a balance of \$739.10. After a 100 dollar check to Concordia for use of their facilities we had a balance of \$639.10 as of 9/11/2019.

No speaker this meeting, but Cindy presented information on the Glen Avenue project. Of the 1.4 million dollars for the project 218,000 are for upgrades to the stoplights. 300,000 dollars from the motor fuel tax will be used towards the project. Work will start in 2021. Plan will be developed the winter. IDOT has to approve the plan. There will possibly be a meeting in March of 2020. There may be drawings and a timeline at that stage.

Public meeting will be held to view the design, see the timeline, learn about access points and give design input.

After discussion of the Glen Avenue project an update was given on the neighborhood watch. A meeting is scheduled with block captains and Sgt. Rummans will be held 9/16/2019. The association needs someone to replace Nelson as a block captain. Pat Kaiser volunteered to take Nelson's position.

At the next association meeting, 11/13/2019, more concrete details will be given.
